Water Baptism, our Christian Duty- of -Son ship!

As Believers in **The Christ**, we need to ask ourselves a very important Question: Are we willing to Obey **Christ's** Commands and enter into **Son ship with Him?**

Sonship with God, the Holy Father, only comes through Obedience to Him. Even Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, Obediently submitted to God in Water Baptism. If anyone could have by-passed Water Baptism, the Only Begotten Son of the Holy God, certainly could have., we would think? **But instead He would set an example of the Path to Sonship, in Perfect Obedience.**

The Son of God, Jesus Christ, gave us a precious few commands to follow as His Believers!

Not only did He give us commandment to

be Water Baptized, (Matt 28:19, Mark 16:16) **He also gave us His Personal Example:**

Mt 3:1-2, 5-6. About this time John the Baptist made his appearance, preaching in the Desert of Judaea. "Repent," he said, "for the Kingdom of the Heavens is now close at hand." Then large numbers of people went out to him-- people from Jerusalem and from all Judaea, and from the whole of the Jordan valley-- and were Baptized by him in the Jordan, making full confession of their sins. Mt 3:13-17.

Just at that time **Jesus**, coming from Galilee to the Jordan, presents Himself to John to be Baptized by him.

John protested. "It is I,"

he said, "who have need to be Baptized by You, and do You come to me?" **Jesus** said, "Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all Righteousness." Then he consented; and Jesus was Baptized, and immediately went up from the Water. At that moment the heavens opened, and he saw the **Spirit of God** descending like a dove and alighting upon **Him**, while a Voice came from Heaven, saying, "**This is My Son, the dearly loved, in whom is My delight.**" (WNT).

Jesus Christ, not only submitted to Water Baptism, but walked in this example, passing on this rite of Water Baptism to His Disciples., to Baptize other Followers of His. -now read John 4:1-2.
