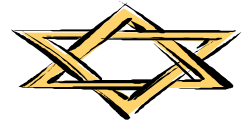
JUNE 2006 Balaam: Israel in the eyes of The Almighty

“Behold, there is a people come out from Egypt: behold, they cover the face of the earth, and they abide over against me: Nu 22:10 (KJV) And Balaam said unto God, Balak the son of Zippor, king of Moab (Jordan), hath sent unto me, saying, Behold, there is a people come out of Egypt, which covereth the face of the earth: come now, curse me them; peradventure I shall be able to overcome them, and drive them out. And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are Blessed..... And the LORD put a word in Balaam's mouth, and said, Return unto Balak, and thus thou shalt speak. And he took up his parable, and said, Balak the king of Moab hath brought me from Aram, out of the mountains of the east, saying, Come, curse me Jacob, and come, defy Israel. How shall I curse, whom God hath not cursed? or how shall I defy, whom the LORD hath not defied? For from the top of the rocks I see him, and from the hills I behold him: lo, the people shall dwell alone, and shall not be reckoned among the nations. Who can count the dust of Jacob, and the number of the fourth part of Israel? Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his! ..And the LORD met Balaam, and put a word in his mouth, and said, Go again unto Balak, and say thus. And he took up his parable, and

said, Rise up, Balak, and hear; hearken unto me, thou son of Zippor: Nu 23:19 GOD is not a man, that He should lie; neither the son of man, that He should repent: hath He said, and shall He not do it? or hath He spoken, and shall He not make it good? Behold, I have received commandment to bless: and He hath blessed; and I cannot reverse it. He hath not beheld iniquity in Jacob, neither hath He seen perverseness in Israel: the LORD his God is with him, and the shout of a King (David/Solomon/Jesus) is among them. God brought them out of Egypt; he hath as it were the strength of an unicorn. Nu 23:23 Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, neither is there any divination against Israel: according to This Time it shall be said of Jacob and of Israel, What hath God wrought! (WHY DO THE NATIONS RAGE, And the people imagine a vain thing? Read Psalm 2). Behold, the people shall rise up as a Great Lion, and lift up himself as a young lion: he shall not lie down until he



eat of the prey, and drink the blood of the slain. And Balak said unto Balaam, Neither curse them at all, nor bless them at all. But Balaam answered and said unto Balak, Told not I thee, saying, All that the LORD speaketh, that I must do? And Balak said unto Balaam, Come, I pray thee, I will bring thee unto another place; peradventure it will please God that thou mayest curse me them from thence. And Balaam lifted up his eyes, and he saw Israel abiding in his tents according to their tribes; and the Spirit of GOD came upon him. And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said: He hath said, which heard the words of God, which saw the vision of The Almighty, falling into a trance, but having his eyes open: How goodly are thy tents, O Jacob, and thy tabernacles, O Israel! As the valleys are they spread forth, as gardens by the river's side, as the trees of lign aloes which the LORD hath planted, and as cedar trees beside the water. He shall pour the water out of his buckets, and his seed shall be in many waters, and his King shall be higher than Agag, and his Kingdom shall be Exalted. God brought him forth out of Egypt; he hath as it were the strength of an unicorn: he shall eat up the nations his enemies, and shall break their bones, and pierce them through with his Arrows.”



# Blessed with THE THREEFOLD BLESSING

Nu 24:9 He couched (down on the knees in reverence to God), he lay down as a lion, and as a great lion: who shall stir him up? Blessed is he that blesseth thee (Israel), and cursed is he that curseth thee (Israel).

And Balak's anger was kindled against Balaam, and he smote his hands together: and Balak said unto Balaam, I called thee to curse mine enemies, and, behold, thou hast altogether **blessed**

**them these three times.**

Therefore now flee thou to thy place: I thought to promote thee unto great honour; but, lo, **the LORD** hath kept thee back from honour. **(how much of the Anti-christ wealth supports many anti-Israel Terrorists today?)**

And Balaam (Balaam: means, "not of the people" he was a man endowed by **The LORD** with the gift of Prophecy. His name appears 60 times in the Bible)

said unto Balak, Spake I not also to thy messengers which thou sentest unto me, saying, If **Balak =(devastator)** would give me his house full of silver and gold (Money), **I cannot go beyond the commandment of the LORD, to do either good or bad of mine own mind; but what the LORD saith, that will I speak?**

And now, behold, I go unto my people: come therefore, and I will advertise thee **what this people shall do to thy people in the latter days.**

## A STAR OUT OF JACOB



Nu 24:15-19 (KJV). And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and **the man whose eyes are open** hath said:

**He hath said, which heard the words of God, and knew the knowledge**

**of the most High, which saw the vision of the Almighty, falling into a trance, but having his eyes open:**

I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: **there shall come a Star (King David), out**

**of Jacob, and a Scepter (rod of Authority) shall rise out of Israel =(God Prevails)** and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth =(seat of body, buttocks).

And Edom (descendants of Esau, a land S.E. of Israel) shall be a possession, Seir also shall be a possession for his enemies; **and Israel shall do valiantly. Out of Jacob shall come he that shall have Dominion,** and shall destroy him that remained of the city =( 'iyar = the excitement & anguish of terror removed from a city wakeful and guarded).



## THE Awful Reward ON ALL THOSE WHO ATTACK THE NATION ISRAEL

Nu 24:20 And when he looked on Amalek (dweller in a valley), he took up his parable, and said, Amalek was the first of the nations (to attack Israel coming unto The Promised Land: In: (Ex 17:8 "Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim" "And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword." Ex 17:14 **"And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this for a memorial in a book, and rehearse it in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly put out the**

**remembrance of Amalek from under heaven"**). but his latter end shall be that he perish for ever.

Nu 24:21 And he looked on the Kenites (of the Midianites), and took up his parable, and said, Strong is thy dwelling-place, and thou puttest thy nest in a rock.

Nu 24:22 Nevertheless the Kenite shall be wasted, until Asshur (Assyria) shall carry thee away captive.

Nu 24:23 And he took up his

parable, and said, Alas, who shall live when God doeth this!

Nu 24:24 And ships shall come from the coast of Chittim (Cyprus), and shall afflict Asshur, and shall afflict Eber (Syria), and he also shall perish for ever.

Nu 24:25 And Balaam rose up, and went and returned to his place: and Balak also went his way. (read 1st Chronicles Ch 18 for the conquests of King David)
