We are telling the same story mentioned anywhere in the 4 Writings of The Everlasting Gospel. Together, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, Tell what they heard, and saw JESUS CHRIST do.



Of JESUS CHRIST, Conceived By The HOLY SPIRIT

JESUS FEEDS 5,000 HUNGRY MEN, AND THEIR FAMILIES.

John 6:4-5 "And the <u>Passover</u>, a feast of the Jews, was nigh. When JESUS then lifted up His eyes, and saw a great company come unto Him, <u>He</u> saith unto <u>Philip</u>, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat? (The LORD's Passover is <u>first</u> mentioned in Exodus 12:11).

6:6 "And this <u>He</u> said to prove him: for <u>He Himself</u> knew what <u>He</u> would do. (<u>JESUS</u> The Teacher, often proved: peirazo, pi-rad'-zo = <u>tested</u> <u>His</u> disciples. <u>This would have been Philip's chance to say</u>, '<u>Teacher</u>, It's time for Another Miracle from You!" Listen in...

6:7 "Philip answered <u>Him</u>, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is <u>not sufficient</u> for them, <u>that everyone of them may take a little</u>. (Philip was looking at how they would fail, even if they had 200 pennyworth in their Alms bag. But he was Not Remembering <u>JESUS All Sufficiency</u>, and <u>Miracle Working Power</u>. And <u>JESUS</u> was not talking about just an Appetizer for these 5,000. 200 Pennyworth: denarion, day-nar'-ee-on = 200 denarius).

6:8-9 "One of <u>His</u> disciples, <u>Andrew</u>, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto <u>Him</u>, There is a <u>Lad here</u>, <u>which hath Five barley Loaves</u>, and <u>Two Small Fishes</u>: but what are they among so many? (Again, they are looking at the <u>little</u> they had to work with. Not What <u>JESUS</u> Could Do with it, though it be <u>little</u> to work with).

6:10 "And JESUS Said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the Men sat down, in number about Five Thousand (5,000). (The disciples would get All the men: Anthropos, to sit down in the grass. And the Men: aner = Males equaled about 5,000. The Males plus their Wives and Families could have numbered much more, even 10,000+).

6:11 "And JESUS Took the Loaves; and when He had Given Thanks, He distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and Likewise the Fishes as many as they would. (Given Thanks: eucharisteo, yoo-khar-is-teh'-o = to thank, be thankful, express gratitude, say grace before a meal. This same Greek

word is used in Romans 1:21-22 "Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him Not As God, Neither Were Thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. (God requires Thankfulness from His Creatures). Professing themselves to be wise, they Became Fools. (The World's Professors of evolution, and other godless doctrine of the devils). Because of JESUS Thankfulness, the 5,000 Men and their Families Ate As Much As They Willed.

John 6:12 "When they were Filled, HE Said unto His disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be Lost. (There are so many human beings Starving on this planet, because Food is Wasted in countless ways. Here we see JESUS CHRIST wasting no food, that other poor and hungry people could eat. Gather up: Collect. The fragments: broken pieces. That remain: be in excess. That nothing: in order that no one piece be Lost: apollymi = be destroyed, perish. In the Last days of this Age, there tends to be a Lot of Wasting of Food that could be Gathered for the hungry poor).

6:13 "Therefore they <u>Gathered</u> them together, and Filled Twelve Baskets with the Fragments of the Five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten. (The bread fragments left over from the 5 barley loaves filled 12 small baskets full. Bread will last till it's eaten. The Idea is to waste nothing save-able that the hungry could Eat). This Miracle of <u>JESUS</u> Produced not only Enough food to Feed 5,000 hungry Men and their Families, but Left Overs to Fill the 12 Baskets Full).

6:14 "Then those men, when they had seen the Miracle that <u>JESUS</u> Did, said, This is of a <u>Truth That Prophet</u> that should come into the World. (The CHRIST).

6:15 "When <u>JESUS</u> therefore perceived that they would come and take Him by force, to make Him a King, <u>He</u> departed again into a <u>mountain</u> Himself alone. (Perhaps the Golan Heights)? On the next page below we will look at the Account given by Matthew, Mark and Luke of JESUS Feeding the 5,000 Men and their Wives and Children.

Matthew 14:15-21 "And when it was evening, His disciples came to Him, saying, This is a desert place, and the time is now past; send the multitude away, that they may go into the villages. And buy themselves victuals. (desert: eremos, er'-ay-mos = Solitary place. It was not a arid desert, because there was grass. But it was remote to the villages. Time: hora = hour. Past ... probably sunset. Victuals: broma, bro'-mah = eating food. So Matthew tells us the disciples wanted to send the 5,000 Men and their families into the villages to find food to buy for themselves. But what village could have fed such a throng of people).

14:16-18 "But <u>JESUS</u> Said unto them, They need not <u>depart</u>; give ye them to eat. And they say unto Him, We have here but Five Loaves, and Two Fishes. And He Said, Bring them hither to Me. (<u>depart</u>: aperchomai = go away. Give ye them to Eat. Even with a little, we can help some. 5 loaves and 2 fishes + Plus A Miracle From <u>JESUS</u>).

14:19 "And HE commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the Five Loaves, and the Two Fishes, and Looking Up To Heaven, HE Blessed, and Brake, and Gave the loaves to His disciples, and His disciples to the multitude.

(JESUS Knew FATHER God was the Source of all things. HE Blessed: eulogeo, yoo-log-eh'-o = To Speak Well Of. JESUS Never complained to FATHER, but was always Thankful for what HE had to work with. When We Look Up To FATHER God, We Recover our sight for our situation. When JESUS Brake the Loaves, HE Already Began The Multiplication of the Loaves to His 12 disciples, and to the 5,000 Men & their Families).

14:20-21 "And they did All Eat, and were Filled: and they took up of the fragments that Remained Twelve Baskets Full. And they that had Eaten were about Five Thousand Men, Beside Women and Children.

Mark 6:35-44 "And when the day was now Far Spent, His disciples came unto Him, and said, This is a desert place, and now the Time is Far Passed: (Often we do not Realize how Far Past time really is).

6:36 "Send them away, that they may go into the country round about, and into the villages, and buy themselves bread: for they have nothing to eat. (Many people have little money to buy food. And often they are just sent away, instead of being fed, because people don't think they have anything to give).

6:37-38 "He answered and said unto them, Give ye them to Eat. And they say unto Him, Shall we go and buy Two Hundred Pennyworth of Bread, and give them to Eat? He saith unto them, How many Loaves have ye? go and see. And when they knew, they say, Five, and Two Fishes. (GOD never asks how Little we have, but how Much we have for Him to Work with. Originally GOD Made Everything Out Of Nothing).

6:39-40 "And He commanded them to make all sit down by <u>Companies</u> upon the green grass. And they sat down in <u>Ranks</u>, by <u>Hundreds</u>, and <u>Fifties</u>. (<u>Companies</u>: symposion, soom-pos'-ee-on = parties. Upon the <u>Green Grass</u>. <u>In Ranks</u>: Prasia, Pras-ee-ah' = Garden-Plots. <u>GOD</u> is the <u>GOD of Order</u>, <u>not</u> the 'god of chaos'...the devil & his demonic beings).

6:41 "And when <u>HE</u> had taken the Five Loaves and the Two Fishes, <u>HE</u> Looked Up To Heaven, and Blessed, and Brake the Loaves, and Gave them to <u>His</u> disciples to set before them; and the <u>Two Fishes divided <u>HE</u> among them all. (divided: into parts).</u>

6:42-44 "And they did All Eat, and were Filled. And they took Up Twelve Baskets Full of the fragments, and (also) of the Fishes. And they that did Eat of the Loaves were about Five Thousand Men.

<u>Luke 9:12-17</u> "And when the day began to wear away, then came the Twelve, and said unto <u>Him</u>, Send the Multitude away, that they may go into the towns and country round about, and <u>Lodge</u>, and get Victuals: for we are here in a desert place. (Lodge: katalyo, kat-al-oo'-o = to loose down, ungird).

9:13-15 "But HE Said unto them, Give ye them to Eat. And they said, We have No More But Five Loaves and Two Fishes; Except we should Go and Buy meat for all this people. For they were about Five Thousand Men. And HE Said unto His disciples, Make them sit down by Fifties in a Company. And they did so, and made them all to sit down.

9:16-17 "Then <u>HE</u> took the Five Loaves and the Two Fishes, and Looking Up To Heaven, <u>HE</u> Blessed them, and Brake, and Gave to the disciples to set before the Multitude. And they did Eat, and were All Filled: and there was Taken Up of the fragments that Remained to them Twelve Baskets. (<u>Filled</u>: chortazo, khor-tad'-zo = Gorged, Satisfied).
