Luke 11:37-44 "And As HE Spake, A Certain Pharisee Besought HIM To Dine With Him: And HE Went In, And Sat Down To Meat.

(<u>Besought</u>: Erotao = <u>Asked</u>. (By A Certain Pharisee In Preferred Position). <u>HIM To Dine</u>: Aristao = <u>To Take A Dinner Meal At Lunch</u>, In The Middle Of The Day. (Deipnon would have been Supper, In The Evening). <u>With</u>: Para = Close Beside Him. <u>And Sat Down</u>: (Anapipto = Recline At Table, To Lean Back) <u>To Meat</u> (To Eat).

38. And When The Pharisee Saw It, He Marveled That HE Had Not First Washed Before Dinner.

(And: <u>But Now. When The Pharisee Saw:</u> Eido = Be Aware, Considered, He <u>Marvelled:</u> Thaumazo = Wondered That (Because) HE Had Not <u>First:</u> (Proton = At The Beginning) <u>Washed:</u> Baptizo = <u>To Dip</u>, <u>Wash Ceremonially</u> Before Dinner).

39. And The <u>Lord</u> Said Unto Him, Now Do Ye Pharisees Make Clean The Outside Of The Cup And The Platter; But Your Inward Part Is Full Of Ravening And Wickedness.

(And The Lord: Kurios = Master Said: Epo = Answered his wondering. Unto (Towards) him The Pharisee, Now (Nun = In The Present) do ye Pharisees (Separatists, Purists. 6,000 in all (According to Josephus Antiquities 17, 2, 4). Make Clean: Katharizo = To Cleanse, Removing All Admixture On The

Outside: Exothen = From Without, The Exterior. Of The Cup: Poterion = Wine Cup, Or Drinking Cup. And (Also) The Platter: Pinax = Dish, Plate. But Your Inward Part: Esothen = From Within, Inside, Mind, Soul. Is Full Of Ravening: Harpage = Pillage, Plundering, Robbery By Violent Greed. And Wickedness: Poneria = Iniquity, Causing Others Pain, Laborious Trouble, Drudgery (Criminal high charges, high interest rates). Evil Desires, Purposes, Malice, and Plots.

40. Ye Fools, Did Not HE That Made That Which Is Without Make That Which Is Within Also?

(Ye <u>Fools</u>: Aphron = Inconsiderate, Senseless, Without Reason, Short Sighted, Willfully Ignorant, Lacking The Overall Perspective, Not Considering The Consequences. <u>Did Not HE (CREATOR)</u>, <u>That Made That Which Is Without</u>: <u>Exothen = From Without</u>, <u>External (Human Body)</u>, <u>Make That Which Is Within</u>: <u>Esothen = Inside</u>, <u>Within</u>, <u>The Inner Part (Soul = Mind, Will, Emotions) Inwardly, The Inner Man</u>. <u>Also</u>? (Read Romans 7:22. 2nd Cor 4:16. Romans 2:29).

41. But Rather Give Alms Of Such Things As Ye Have; And, Behold, All Things Are Clean Unto You.

Of Such Things As Ye Have: Eneimi = To Be In, Within. And, Behold: Look, All Things Are: Esti = Come, Consist. Clean: Katharos = Clean Ceremonially, Unstained. Unto You. They Felt Cleansed By Their Giving Of Alms, Instead Of By Repentance, Or, Receiving Their Soul Savior).

42. But Woe Unto You, Pharisees! For Ye Tithe Mint And Rue And All Manner Of Herbs, And Pass Over Judgment And The Love Of GOD: These Ought Ye To Have Done, And Not To Leave The Other Undone.

(But: Alla = Otherwise, On The Other Hand. Woe: Ouai = Alas, Grief, Denunciation. Unto You, Pharisees! For: Hoti = Because Ye Tithe: Apodekatoo = Offer A Tenth Part, Pay Tithe Of. Mint: Heduosmon = Sweet Smelling Garden-Mint, Peppermint, **Used To Scent Houses And Synagogues.** And Rue: Peganon = A Thick Leafed Plant **Used For Garnishing And Flavoring Foods.** And All Manner Of Herbs: Lachanon = Herbs From A Garden/Potherbs, Vegetables. And Pass Over: Parerchomai = To Pass By, Neglect, Disregard. Judgment: Krisis = Needing A Decision Made. (Krino means to Separate, Distinguish, Judge, Give Verdict against the sin nature). (Krima is the result that goes with a particular judgment). And: Even. The Love: Agape = Goodwill. Of **GOD:** The Supreme Divinity. These Ye Ought: Necessary. To Have Done, And Not Leave The Other Undone.

43. Woe Unto You, Pharisees! For Ye Love The Uppermost Seats In The Synagogues, And Greetings In The Markets.

(<u>The Uppermost Seats</u>: Protokathedria = The Chief Seats, A Sitting In The First Seat, Or Most Honorable Seats. <u>In The Synagogues</u>: An Assembly. <u>And Greetings</u>: Aspasmos = Salutations. <u>In The Markets</u>: Agora = Public Place Of Forum, Assembly,

To Buy/Sell. Most Frequented Place In The City, If Wanting Attention, Or Sales).

44. Woe Unto You, Scribes And Pharisees, Hypocrites! For Ye Are As Graves Which Appear Not, And The Men That Walk Over Them Are Not Aware Of Them.

(Scribes: Grammateus = A Public Writer. Learned In Law, Town Clerk or City Secretary, Recorder. Hypocrites: Hupokrites = Actors In A Stage Play. Actors Performing Under A Mask, A Two Faced Person, Profession Not Matching Their Practice. Saying Something But Acting Another Way. A Dissembler, Rather Than An Assembler). For (Because) Ye Are As (Like) Graves: Mnemeion = A Memorial, Monument, Tomb, place Of Interment. Empty Tomb Honoring A Dead Person. Or, An Unmarked Grave. Which Appear Not: Adelos = Unseen, Not Manifest To The Eve And Not Obvious To People. And (Even) The Men (Anthropos = Mankind) That Walk Over (Above) Them Are Not Aware Of Them. Now, We Read ...

Romans 2:29 "But he is a Jew, which is one Inwardly; and circumcision is that of the Heart, in the Spirit, and not in the Letter; whose Praise Is Not Of Men, But Of GOD."

Romans 7:22 "For I Delight In The Law Of GOD After <u>The Inward Man</u>."
