When your hand is on the plough, don't look back.

Luke 9:57-62 "And it came to pass, that, as they went in the way, a certain man said unto Him, Lord, I will follow Thee whithersoever Thou goest. (As they were walking: poreuomenon = to travel along the <u>way</u>: hodo = road (to Jerusalem to die). A certain man said toward Him, Lord: kurios = Master. I will follow Thee <u>wheresoever</u> Thou goest).

9:58 "And JESUS said unto him, Foxes have <u>holes</u>, the birds of the air have <u>nests</u>; but the Son of man hath not where to <u>lay His head</u>. (<u>Holes</u>: pholeos = burrows. <u>Nests</u>: kataskenosis = a place for roosting in. <u>Lay</u>: klino = to lay, incline).

9:59 "And He said unto another, Follow ME, but he said, <u>Lord</u>, suffer me <u>First</u> to go and bury my father. (<u>Lord</u>: kurios = Master. <u>Suf-</u><u>fer</u>: epitrepo = to turn over on, commit to me <u>First</u> to go and bury my Father. (Burying ones Father is a Noble Act. But here the Priority of Obeying the Master in Preaching the Gospel was delayed, as JESUS goes to His death in Jerusalem).

9:60 "JESUS said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: <u>But go thou and Preach the</u> <u>Kingdom Of GOD</u>. (The Spiritually Dead Need The Gospel More than the physically dead. Once a man is physically <u>dead</u>: nekros, <u>his Soul and Spirit</u> <u>are Gone</u>. There is no helping him Spiritually, if his Soul was not <u>Saved while his human body was still</u> <u>alive</u>. (No mention of purgatory in the Bible. You have to <u>Believe and Receive SAVIOR</u> before dying). 9:61 "And another also said, <u>Lord</u>, I will follow Thee; But let me <u>First</u> go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house. (Again they call <u>Him Lord</u>: kurios = Master. But want their Will to be First. And <u>JESUS</u> Is on the road to Jerusalem to die).

9:62 "And JESUS said unto him, No man, having <u>Put his hand to the Plough, and</u> <u>looking back</u>, is fit for the Kingdom of GOD. (Put: epiballo = to cast or throw upon his hand: cheir = hand and arm. To the Plough. Once a person hears JESUS Call to Follow Him, he should not put it off till it is more Convenient). (1 Kings 19:19-21). Fit: euthetos = well or conveniently placed for the Kingdom Of GOD). (Luke 14:26-35).

Matthew 8:19 "And a certain scribe came, and said unto Him, <u>Master</u>, I will follow Thee withersoever Thou goest.

8:20 "And JESUS saith unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay His head. (<u>HE</u> Is <u>Head</u> of the <u>Church</u>).

8:21 "And another of <u>His</u> disciples said unto <u>Him</u>, <u>Lord</u>, suffer me <u>First</u> to go and bury my father. (The world is dying in sin).

8:22 "But JESUS said unto him, <u>Follow</u> <u>ME</u>; And let the dead bury their dead.
