JESUS REBUKES THE GREAT WINDS, AND THE STORMY SEA.

Mark 4:35 "And the same day, when eve was come, He saith unto them, Let us Pass Over unto the other side. (JESUS has just Taught all day long around Capernaum, finishing with His parable of the Net. But in His Spirit as evening was approaching, He knew He had to go Across the cast, throw upon. Into: eis = Sea of Galilee to the Eastern Side. Pass Over: dierchomai, dee-er'-khom-ahee = Go Through unto the other Side: peran, per'-an = To Pierce Through, Bevond, Over, on the other side, Across).

4:36 "And when they had sent away the multitude, they took Him even as He was in the Ship. And there were also with Him other little ships. (Multitude: ochlos, okh'-los = a Throng of people. Ship: ploion, ploy'-on = A Sailing Vessel. (for plunging through the Sea). Other little ships: ploiarion, ploy-ar'-ee-on = little ships, boats.

4:37 "And there Arose a ... Great Storm of Wind, and

the Waves Beat Into The Ship, So that It Was Now Full. (Great: megas, meg'-as = big. Storm: lailaps, lah'eelaps = a whirlwind, violent storm. Of wind, and the waves: kyma, koo'-mah = to swell, billow, bursting upon, toppling. **Beat:** epiballo = to into the ship: ploion = Sailing Vessel, so that it was now Full: gemizo, ghem-id'-zo = to fill entirely).

4:38 "And He was in the hinder part of the Ship, Asleep on a pillow: and they awake Him, and say unto Him, Master, Carest Thou not that we perish? (hinder part of the ship: prymna, proom'nah = stern. It was the wide rear part of the ship, where **JESUS** could Sleep. (The front, or 'Bow' of a Sailing Vessel is Pointed, with no room to sleep). Asleep on a **<u>Pillow</u>**: proskephalaion, pros-kef-al'-ahee-on = a cushion for the head, pillow. (On a wood Ship). And they awake: diegeiro, dee-eg-i'-ro =

to wake fully. Him, and say to Him, Master: didaskalos = **Teacher, Instructor. Carest:** mel'-o = to be of interest to, concern. Thou not that we Perish: apollymi, ap-ol'-loo-mee = to destroy fully, die. It is the Devil who Destroys that Stirred up the Wind; Not JESUS).

4:39 "And HE Arose, and Rebuked the wind, and Said unto the Sea, Peace, Be Still. And the Wind Ceased, and there Was a Great Calm. (HE Rebuked: epitimao, ep-ee-tee-mah'-o = Chide, Scold, Set a Weight upon (the Weight of His Rebuke on the Wind: anemos, an'-em-os = wind (from the 4 directions). **Ceased:** kop-ad'-zo = to relax. And Said unto the Sea: Thalassa, thal'-as-sah = Sea. **<u>Peace</u>**: siopao, see-o-pah'-o = Silence, hush, involuntary stillness. Be still: phimoo, fee-mo'-o = to muzzle, hold one's peace. And there was a **Great Calm:** galene = Tranquility. The Sea of Galilee is Normally Serene.

Mark 4:40 "And HE Said unto them, Why are ye So Fearful? How is it that ye have No Faith? (Fearful: deilos, di-los' = Timid: showing a lack of Courage and **Confidence.** After Discipling these Men for over a year now, **JESUS** was probably expecting them to be Bolder, even against the wind, In JESUS Name, themselves. Sometimes we are So Timid in **Ourselves, and we Expect JESUS** to come running to our Rescue. How is it that ye have: echo, ekh'-o = Hold, Keep. No Faith: pistis, pis'tis = Faith, Faithfulness, Steadfastness. (Faith Overcomes fear).

4:41 "And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of Man is This, That Even the Wind and the Sea Obey HIM. (Feared: phobeo, fob-eh'-o = to cause fear, terrify. Exceedingly: fobos = frightened. What manner of Man: ara, ar'-ah = drawing a conclusion, an inference more decisive. Realizing the God/ Man Incarnation. That Even the Wind and the Sea Obey: hypakouo, hoop-ak-oo'-o = To Hearken Submissively, Hear Under, **Obev as a Subordinate, Listen** Attentively, Heed or Conform to a Command of an Authority.

LETS PICK UPON THE SAME EVENT IN THE BOOK OF <u>LUKE</u>:

Luke 8:22 "Now it came to pass on a certain day, that HE went into a Ship with His disciples: and HE Said unto them, Let us go Over unto the Other Side of the Lake: The Sea of Galilee is also called Lake Tiberias, Kinneret, or Kinnereth. It is a Huge freshwater lake in Israel, and the Lowest freshwater lake on earth. The only Sea that is Lower is the Salt Sea (dead sea) in Israel). The Lake Tiberias is 33 Miles in Circumference and about 13 miles long, 8 1/2 miles wide. So it is huge, and is fed by the Jordan River and Underground Springs as well).

8:23 "But as they Sailed HE fell Asleep: and there <u>came down</u> a <u>Storm of Wind on the Lake</u>; and they were <u>Filled with Water</u>, and were in Jeopardy. (<u>Came down</u>: katabaino, kat-ab-ah'ee-no = to descend. <u>A Storm</u>: tempest, squall, whirlwind. <u>Filled</u>: sympleroo, soom-play-ro'-o = to swamp, fill up. With Water, and were in Jeopardy: kindyneuo, kin-doon-yoo'-o = to undergo Peril. Be in Danger).

8:24 "And they came to Him, and awoke Him, saying, Master, master, we Perish. Then HE Arose, and Rebuked the Wind and the **Raging of the Water: and they** Ceased, and there was a Calm. (Master: epistates, ep-is-tat'-ace = Superintendent, One Who Stands Over. Rebuked: epitimao, ep-eetee-mah'-o = To Set A Weight Upon, Chide. The Wind and the Raging: klydon, kloo'-dohn= The Surge of the Sea, Raging Waves. **Ceased:** pauo, pow'-o = to Stop, restrain, desist, come to an end. And there was a Calm: Tranquility.

8:25 "And HE Said unto them, <u>Where is your Faith</u>? And they being Afraid Wondered, saying to one to another, What Manner Of Man Is This! For HE <u>Com-</u> <u>mandeth</u> Even The Winds And Water, And They <u>Obey</u> HIM. (<u>Where</u>: pou = in what locality. <u>Is</u> <u>Your Faith</u>? Even with <u>JESUS</u> With them, their Faith came up Missing? <u>HE Commandeth</u>: Orders the Wind and Water, and they <u>Obey</u>: To Hear Under, Conform to a Command of Authority (from) <u>Him</u>:

NOW WE GO TO MATTHEW

Matt 8:23-25 "And when HE was entered into a Ship, His disciples followed Him. And, behold, there Arose a Great Tempest in the Sea, insomuch that the <u>Ship was Covered with</u> the Waves: but HE was Asleep. And His disciples came to Him, and awoke Him, saying, <u>Lord</u>, <u>Save</u> us: we Perish. (Save: sozo, sode'-zo = to save, keep sound).

8:26 "And HE Saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little Faith? Then HE Arose, And <u>Rebuked The Winds And The Sea;</u> And there was a <u>Great Calm</u>.

8:27 "But the Men Marveled, saying, What Manner Of Man Is This, That Even The Winds And The Sea <u>Obey</u> HIM. (Marveled: thaumazo, thoumad'-zo = to admire, have in admiration, wonder. Manner of Man: potapos, pot-ap-os' = What possible sort, or manner? That Even The Winds And The Sea <u>Obe</u>y: hypakouo, hoop-akoo'-o = Hearken Submissively, to Hear Under, as a Subordinate to HIM). (Romans 1:5. 5:19. 16:26).

Since Even The Winds And The Seas Obey HIM, How Much More Obedient Should We Be To JESUS CHRIST, Our Savior.

Obedience To The Gospel Is Not An Option For Those Who Wish To Be <u>Saved</u>. We Must All Call Out To <u>JESUS CHRIST</u>, Just Like HIS Disciples Did, To Be <u>Saved</u> From The Sea Of... Humanity. (2nd Corinthians 10:5).
