JESUS HEALS THE BLIND MAN.

Mark 8:22-26 "And HE (JESUS) Cometh to BethSaida; and they bring a Blind man unto Him, and besought Him to Touch him. (JESUS Comes into the Town of Bethsaida: House of Fishing. N.E. Side Of The Sea of Galilee. There were people in Bethsaida who Really Believed in **JESUS** Touch and Power. So they bring a Blind man: typhlos, toof-los' = blind, unto Him, and besought: parakaleo = to call to one's side. Him to Touch: haptomai = to attach oneself to him. This is 1 of 3 Towns where JESUS did Many of His Miracles. And, in the Grassy land below it, JESUS Fed The 5,000 Men. (There was Another town, called Beth Saida: Place of Nets, on the West Side of Galilee, the Native Town of Andrew, Peter and Philip, 3 of the Fishermen/Disciples. But this town 'Bethsaida' is on the East Side of Galilee).

8:23 "And <u>He</u> (JESUS) <u>Took the Blind man</u> by the hand, and Lead him Out of the <u>Town</u>; and when <u>He</u> had spit On his eyes, and put <u>His Hands</u> Upon him, <u>He</u> Asked him If he Saw ought. (JESUS Is Very Tenderhearted; as He takes the <u>Blind man</u> by the <u>hand</u>: cheir = hollow hand for grasping, or arm for leading. and <u>Led</u>: exago, ex-ag'-o to lead forth. <u>him</u> <u>out of</u>: exo = outside. <u>The town</u>: Ko'-may = town, hamlet, village. <u>And when He had spit</u>: ptyo, ptoo'-o = to spit. Even the spit from the Mouth Of

ptoo'-o = to spit. Even the spit from the Mouth Of The <u>WORD</u> Was <u>Holy And Powerful</u>. On: eis = into. <u>his Eyes</u> (washing his eyes out). <u>And Put His</u> <u>Hands Upon him</u> (Power Flowing Through <u>JESUS</u> Hands) <u>He Asked him if he saw Ought</u>: ei tis = Anything?

8:24 "And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. (and he Looked Up: anablepo = To Look Up To GOD, he begins to Recover Some Sight. But We Should Keep Looking Up. Then we will See People in the Clear Image Of GOD. People are far more Valuable than <u>Trees</u>: dendron, from drus = an Oak. <u>Walking</u>: peripateo, per-ee=pat-eh'-o = to walk around, tread all around).

8:25 "After That <u>HE</u> Put <u>His</u> Hands Again Upon his eyes, and made him Look Up: And he was Restored, and Saw Every Man Clearly. (<u>JESUS</u> Puts <u>His</u> Hands Once More Upon him... A Second Time... and made him Look Up: and he was Restored: Reconstituted, Restored Sight. And Saw every man Clearly: telaugos = tay-lowgoce' = In a Far Shining Manner, Plainly).

8:26 "And <u>He</u> Sent him away to his house, Saying, Neither go into the town, nor tell it to any in the town. (JESUS Told him Not to Re-enter the Town, but to go to his own Home. So here we See the man had a home Out Of Town, but probably went into the Town to Beg for a Living. JESUS did not want to stir up the Town Pharisees, Sadducees, or Herodians, in Bethsaida, to starting tempting <u>Him</u> for even more Signs. This May Be Why He Took the man Outside the Town, To Heal him. Publicity JESUS did Not Need, and Trouble <u>He</u> did not want. JESUS Must Stay Alive To Finish <u>His</u> Ministry And Make It To The Cross Of Crucifixion).
