## JESUS PAYS, THE STRANGER TRIBUTE TO CAESAR.

It is Significant that JESUS CHRIST was not Roman, He was Jewish, and Paid a Stranger Tribute, in Roman Palestine. And it is only mentioned in Matthew, the Gospel to the Jews: Matthew 17:24-27 "And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received tribute money came to Peter, and said, Doth not your Master pay tribute? (To: eis = Into. Capernaum: cap-er-nah-oom'= A Place In Palestine. Hebrew origin Kaphar Nachuwm = Village of Nahum (The Prophet). It was on the North/West shore of the Sea of Galilee, where Peter and Family lived, and housed **JESUS. Master:** didaskalos, did-as'-kal-os = **Teacher.** Pay: teleo, tel-eh'-o = Pay, complete, discharge a debt, perform. Tribute: didrachmon = A Double Drachma (15 pence). From the root word drassomai or drakon: the captured of Rome Paid. Drak'-own =Dragon = is a fascinating Serpent).

17:25 "He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, JESUS prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? Of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? Of their own children, or of strangers? (Prevented: prof-than'-o = To Get An Earlier Start Of, Anticipate. him. Custom: Telos = Toll (As in Toll Roads of the Roman Highways. A Publican named Levi used to collect these Tolls, in his Toll house, before JESUS Called him Matthew (Mark 2:14. Matthew 9:9. Luke 5:27). (Later Levi would throw a Great Feast, inviting his

friends who were Publicans and sinners... Luke 5:29-32). <u>Or Tribute</u>: Kensos = A Census, Tax. (Later the evil Pharisees and Herodians would Tempt <u>JESUS</u> With the Question, 'Is it Lawful to give Tribute unto Caesar, or not?' Matthew 22:17). <u>Of</u>: apo = Off. Away From. <u>Their Own Chil-</u> <u>dren</u>: huios = Sons. Romans Taxed the people they conquered, because they were not their Roman children. <u>Or Of Strangers</u>: allotrios = Belonging To Another. Both JE-SUS And His Jewish People Belong To GOD, Not To Rome. But still, as Christians we pay tribute/tax... Rom 13:6-7).

17:26 "Peter saith unto Him, Of strangers. <u>JESUS</u> saith unto him, Then are the children <u>Free</u>: Eleutheros, El-yoo'-ther-os = At Liberty).

17:27 "Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for Me and for thee. (But, Lest: hin'-ah may = That Not. We should offend: skan-dal-id'-zo = to cause to stumble. them. go down to the Sea (Galilee), throw in a hook, lift up the first fish, take the coin of money out of his mouth, and Give them for Me and thee.
