Of Heaven: Ouranos = The Abode Of GOD. **Heaven is mentioned 284 times in the Holy** Scripture. Likened: homoioo = Similar. Unto A Man: Anthropos = Manfaced, Human Being. A Certain King: Basileus = A Sovereign, Foundation Of Power. Which Would Take **Account:** Logos = Word, Reckoning. Of His **Servants:** Doulos = Servants. (See logos in Matthew 12:36 giving an account (logos) for idle words. Luke 16:2 an account (logos) of thy stewardship. Acts 19:40. Romans 14:12 "So then everyone of us shall give account (logos) of himself to GOD. Philippians 4:17 to your account (logos). Hebrews 13:17 rulers must give account (logos). 1st Peter 4:5 "Who shall give account (logos = something said, reasoned) to Him that is ready to Judge (krino = to distinguish, decide judicially, try, condemn, punish) the quick (living) and the dead (Nekros = Corpse).
