NATURE IS BEAUTIFUL

"And The LORD God Formed Man From The Dust Of The Ground, And Breathed Into His Nostrils, The BREATH OF LIFE, And Man BECAME A LIVING SOUL." Gen 2:7.

I Never Assume I Know The Meaning Of A Particular Word, Unless I Look It Up, In The Language That It Was Written In, Originally. So Let's Look At The Words Of This Bible Verse:

And **The LORD**: "Self Existent And Eternal."

LORD God: "The Supreme God."

Formed: "To Squeeze Into Shape, Mould Into Form, As A Potter Does."

Man: "Adam" Ruddy, That Is, Human Being. Individual, Or The Species, Mankind. Ruddy= Of A Person's Face, Showing Blood Color, Rosy Red.

Dust Of The Ground: "Adamah" Soil, From It's General Redness.

And Breathed: "To Puff" Expire, Inflate, Blow, Kindle.

Nostrils: "Nose" For Breathing.

The Breath: "Divine Inspiration" Vital Breath, Soul, Spirit.

Man Became A: "To Exist As" Self.

Living Soul: "A Breathing Creature."

So Here We See **The LORD** Creator Father God, Beginning Humanity, And The Human Nature.

WHAT IS THE NATURE OF MAN?

"And The LORD God Said, "It Is Not Good That The Man Should Be Alone; I Will Make Him A Help Meet For Him." Genesis 2:18.

And **The LORD God Said**: "Certified" Attested or Confirmed In A Formal Statement. Challenged, Declared, Determined, Published, Promised, Reported, Intended.

And **HE** Spoke Against Something Not Meeting **HIS** Standard Of Nature.

It Is Not Good: "Tobe" "Not A Good Thing, As It Is" Not Well, Not Best, Not Better, Not Beautiful, Not Bountiful, Not Cheerful, Not Joyful, Not Kind, Not Loving, Not Merry, Not Pleasant, Not Pleasurable, Not Precious, Not Prosperous, Not Sweet, Not Delightful.

That The Man Should Be Alone: It's Not Good For Adam To Exist In Separation. Continually: "Bad" Alone As A Part Of A Body, A Branch Of A Tree. Only, Besides, Of Each Alike.

GOD WOULD DO BETTER!

I WILL MAKE HIM: "Bring Forth For Him" Bruise, Have The Charge Of, Fashion Finish, Fit, Furnish, Fulfill, Pare, Procure, Provide and Serve Him.

A Help: "Aid" "To Surround, That Is, To Protect or Aid. Succor= Assist In Time Of Difficulty. One Who Provides Help, Reinforcement, Comfort, Consolation, Solace, Mercy, Service.

Meet For Him: "A Front, That Is, An Opposite, A Counterpart Or Mate, Before, About, Over Against, In Sight, View, Other Side, Presence.

"And The LORD God Caused A Deep Sleep To Fall Upon Adam, And He Slept: And **HE** Took One Of His (Adam's) Ribs, And Closed Up The Flesh Instead Thereof." Genesis 2:21.

And The LORD God Caused A Deep Sleep: "A Lethargy" Trance. To Stun, Stupefy. (The LORD God Did Not Want Adam Involved In **HIS** Work Of Fashioning A Help Meet For Him. Creator Would Do This, **HIS** Way, Not Adam's Way). What's Also So Interesting Here, Is That Adam Was Made Lethargic. Men Alone Are More Lethargic, Than A Man Married

To His Wife? Single Women Often Look At A Single Man's Lethargy, And Judge His Potential As A Husband, Accordingly. **But The Wise Woman Knows That Her 'Addition' Back Unto His Side, Will Energize Him, Her Husband!**

And He Slept: "To Be Slack Or Languid" Also To Grow Old, or Inveterate. Inveterate= Having A Particular Habit, Or Interest That Is Long Established and Unlikely To Change. Settled or Confirmed In A Habit. (as in, a confirmed bachelor). Established By Long Continuance or Persistence. Ingrained Habit, That Can't Help But Be Expressed. Deep Rooted.

And HE Took One Of Adam's Ribs: Creator Took Away One Rib From Adam. With The One Rib HE Drew Out And Carried Away. Why ONE: "United" So That One Could Be Re-United To Adam! Why Not Several Ribs, **HE** Would Have Had More Of Adam To Work With. The LORD God Didn't Want A Copy Of Adam Masculine. CREATOR Did Not Need More Of Man, Than, What **HE** Took "Out Of Him." That Was Enough, **For TheFEMALE ...HE** Would Fashion, **Would Not Be Masculine**.

CREATOR Was Not Going To "Make A Comparable" For Adam, By Building and Comparing Another Adam With Him. Two Of The Same Do Not Need To Be Compared, they are the same. What **GOD** Compares Is What Fits Together As ONE FLESH! (Gen 2:24).
