In the writings of Peter, (the Apostle of Jesus Christ) he Encourages Husbands to

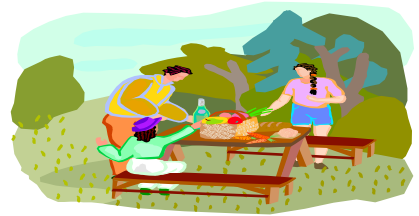
bear up and carry the greater Weight Of Responsibility For and in The Marriage.
