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SAVING YOUR SPOUSE & KIDS

Life is so short and Relationship to Precious to be Careless, Men!

Perfectionism will tend to drive some Christian Men and even Women to try to Change the good Spouse they have. Upon seeing that the pressure their using is not working, they become discouraged and even frustrated to the point of troubling their spouse in other hurtful ways.

It's Time to Accept your Better Half as she or he is, before you ruin your Marriage Relationship:

As life passes year after year, your spouse will go through periods of change. Sometimes changing for what will seem to be beneficial, and sometimes not. Even a Believing Spouse will have spiritually Dry seasons, where they seem to disconnect from GOD. But at these times, be very

Patient. Do not drive them farther away from their Faith Foundation. Pray and quietly Believe for their Restoration:

1st Corinthians. 7: 10-16

"Now to the married I command, yet not I but the Lord: A wife is not to depart from *her* husband. But even if she does depart, let her remain unmarried or be reconciled to *her* husband. And a husband is not to divorce *his* wife.

But to the rest I, not the Lord, say: If any brother has a wife who does not believe, and she is willing to live with him, let him not divorce her. And a woman who has a husband who does not believe, if he is willing to live with her, let her not divorce him. For the unbelieving husband is



sanctified by the Wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified (set apart from the world, unto GOD) by the Husband; otherwise your Children would be unclean, but now they are holy.

But if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such *cases*. But GOD has called us to peace. For how do you know, O wife, whether you will *save your* husband? Or how do you know, O husband, whether you will *save your* wife?

We have the potential of Saving our Spouse and maintaining the holiness of our Children, by our own Faith! Hold your Family Together!
