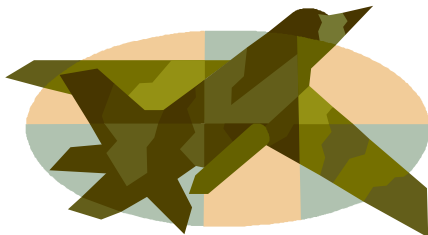
CALLING ON THE GOD WHO NEVER TIRES OF YOU
