## Of JESUS CHRIST, Conceived By The HOLY SPIRIT

### JESUS CHRIST Visits Samaria in route to Jerusalem.

Luke 9:51-56 “And it came to pass, when the time was come that **HE** should be Received Up, **HE** Steadfastly Set **HIS** Face To Go To Jerusalem. (Jerusalem's religious rulers were already planning the death of **JESUS CHRIST**. So **JESUS** had to resolutely ‘Set His Face’ Towards Jerusalem. Every martyr thereafter would have to remember this. As they take up their cross and follow Him. HE Should Be Received Up. Received: analepsis = A Taking Or Receiving Back (Up To HEAVEN). **JESUS Always knew HIS** Ministry on Earth would be Short; **HIS** Cross was already waiting).

9:52 “And Sent Messengers Before **HIS** Face: and they went, and entered into a Village of the Samaritans, to make Ready For **HIM**. (Messengers: aggelos = messengers (James and John). Before: In front of. **HIS** Face. Samaritans: People of the central province of Palestine, West of the Jordan River. The Jews had very little dealings with these people, but **JESUS** Wanted to offer Salvation and healing to them; but they rejected HIM).

9:53 “And they did not receive **HIM**, because **HIS** Face Was As Though **HE** Would Go To Jerusalem. (These Samaritans Lost their chance in a lifetime to Receive **JESUS CHRIST**, all because they hated Jerusalem, and the Jews. Many people are that way today, and they are Lost).

9:54 “And when **HIS** disciples James and

John saw this, they said, **Lord**, wilt **Thou** that we command Fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did? (**JESUS** most trusted disciples were John, James and Peter. **JESUS** must have already Sent Peter ahead to Jerusalem, to prepare for **HIS** Coming there. James and John were called ‘sons of thunder’ rugged fishermen with a temper, that had to be tamed by Love. Some 14 years later The First Apostolic Martyr would be James; in his Love for others. John would become the Apostle of Love and outlived Emperor Domitian, who had exiled John on Prison/Patmos. See 1st, 2nd and 3rd John).

9:55 “But **HE** Turned, and rebuked them, and Said, **Ye know Not what manner of spirit ye are of**. (Rebuked: epitimao = to set a weight upon, chide, (temper). Manner of spirit: Probably an unholy spirit of anger).

9:56 “**For The Son Of Man Is Not Come To Destroy Men's Lives, But To Save Them**. And they went to another village. (Destroy: apollu = to loose off or away, destroy. Many people in the fallen world, think that **JESUS** will take their life away from them. And leave them empty and miserable. Quite the opposite occurs.

John 10:10-11 **JESUS** Said, “**The Thief** (devil) **Cometh Not, But For To Steal, And To Kill, And To Destroy: I AM COME THAT THEY MIGHT HAVE LIFE, AND THAT THEY MIGHT HAVE IT MORE ABUNDANTLY. I AM THE GOOD SHEPHERD: THE GOOD SHEPHERD GIVETH HIS LIFE FOR THE SHEEP.**” —Amen!
