

IN CHRIST: The Veil Is Taken Away. —2 Cor. 3:14.

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Ministering The Holy Spirit and Righteousness Of Christ. In this page we will present the Gospel to the Jewish people. Because The Life of GOD is just beyond the Veil!

The Hebrew Apostle Paul carried a great burden For his Jewish People to believe in Jesus Christ, the Lord; “because the Veil is taken away In Christ.” —2 Cor. 3:14.

In the O.T. the word used by the Jews was “vail” but in the N.T. the word used is “veil.”

When Moses came down from the mountain with the 10 Commandment Law of God, he vailed his face so that people could not see the ‘glory’ of the LORD shining out from him. This ‘vailed glory’ would not last, but would eventually fade away.

The Vail of the Tabernacle, which covered the Ark of the Covenant and the Mercy Seat, shielded the sinful and unholy from The Holy LORD God; and only the high priest could enter through the Vail once a year with the Blood of Atonement which was for himself and for the people. (Lev 16:14-17).

A Vail or Veil is used for Covering something or Someone until the proper time of Un-veiling and Revelation.

In the N.T. we see the death of the Lamb of God Who takes away the sins of the world; therefore God tore open the “Veil” of the Temple. Now, not only the Jews but all of mankind would have access to the Holy LORD God through the blood of the Lamb of God. (Matt 27:51, Mark 15:38 and Luke 23:45).

In 2nd Cor. 3:7-18 We see the Revelation of all of this to the Apostle Paul, and the miracle that happens when the Jewish peo-

ple Receive Christ Jesus their Savior.

The Apostle Paul speaks of 4 Ministries: “But if the ministry of death, written and engraved on stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of the glory of his countenance, which glory was passing away, how will the ministry of the Spirit not be more glorious? For if the ministry of condemnation had glory, the ministry of righteousness exceeds much more in glory. For even what was made glorious had no glory in this respect, because of the glory that excels. For if what is passing away was glorious, what remains is much more glorious. Therefore, since we have such hope, we use such great boldness of speech.” — 2 Cor. 3:7-12.

As a Christian Evangelist, our Ministry is the Ministry of the Spirit and the Ministry of Righteousness!

“Unlike Moses, who put a vail over his face so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the end of what was passing away.

Righteousness by the Law was never reached by the Jew or anyone else. Righteousness came by Christ. “But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away In Christ.”

The Christian Evangelist must Pray that the veil is

lifted by Christ, and the eyes of the mind, see!

“But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart.” 2 Cor. 3:13-15.

The Jew trusts in father Abraham and they continually read the Law, but a veil covers both the mind and the heart, and they cannot fully enjoy the presence or favor of the LORD God.

“Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord (Jesus) the veil is taken away.”

The LORD God tore the vail from top to bottom, but the Lord Jesus Christ completely takes the veil away between the LORD God and man.

“Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.”

This is liberty from trying to please the Holy God by the self-righteousness of trying to live by the Law of Moses!

“But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror, the glory of the Lord (Jesus) are being transformed into the same Image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.” —2 Corinthians 3:16-18.

Those who receive Jesus Christ are transformed from the glory of the Law to the Glory of the Lord.

Those who receive the Ministry of the Spirit and Righteousness In Christ, are set at Liberty!
