Old Testament Covering for Sin, or New Testament Removal Of Sin.

Today, I want to share with you the difference between the Old Testament (First half of the Bible) and the New Testament (2nd half of the Bible).

The problem of disobedience (Sin) began in the Garden of Eden, when Adam and Eve disobeyed Creator, and ate from the Tree of knowledge of good and evil. (Read Genesis 3:1-6). Then read Genesis 3:7. Adam and Eve “sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.”

The word ‘apron’ here is the Hebrew word hagora, pronounced khag-ore’ and means belt for the waist, and girdle. To cover themselves, and their guilt of Sin.

“And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.” Gen 3:8.

Already, here we see many things about Sin and how it leaves mankind naked before the Holy Creator LORD God. We also see that mankind’s own attempts to Cover his Sin, is useless, because it did not take

away his guilt or feeling of nakedness, or fear of God. There have been many ‘religions tailored by man’ to make himself more presentable to god. But man’s fig leaves have failed. Then comes the ‘blame game’ of accusing someone else for our sin and disobedience to God. Finally the blame is placed against the Serpent devil. So everyone shares the consequence of Sin and it’s guilt.

But, in the end mankind must still have a covering for sin, so The LORD Creator made coats. “Unto Adam also and unto his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.” Genesis 3:21.

Coats here is the Hebrew word kuttonet, pronounced keth-o’-neth and means To Cover, Clothe.

So, God had the Sin of Adam and Eve Covered. Nothing more is said about their shame.

The diagnosis of the problem of Adam and Eve, and all the human race thereafter, was ‘Sin’.

Later, in the Old Testament, the Day of Atonement, was intro-

duced as a day to Cover Sin for a year. Ex 30:10.

“And Aaron shall make Atonement upon the horns of (the Altar) once a year with the blood of the Sin Offering of Atonements: Once in the year shall he make Atonement upon it throughout your generations: it is most holy unto the LORD.”

Atonement: here is the Hebrew word kapar, pronounced kaw-far’ meaning; To Cover, put off away from. Taking away guilt by means of an Offering, ransom, vicarious sacrifice.

All through the Old Testament the Sin of the people is Covered by Sacrifice and Offerings. But Covering up Sin doesn’t take it away entirely. There had to be a New Testament, To Remove Sin.

“Wherefore when HE (JESUS) Came into the world, HE Said, “Sacrifice and Offering You did not desire, BUT A BODY YOU HAVE PREPARED FOR ME. In burnt offerings and sacrifices for Sin, YOU HAD NO PLEASURE. THEN SAID I, LO, I COME.

—Hebrews 10:5.

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Lo, I Come. In the Volume of The Book it is Written if ME.

“Then I Said, Lo, I Come. In the Volume of The Book It Is Written Of ME, To Do Thy Will, O God. Above when HE Said, Sacrifice and Offering, and burnt offerings and offering for Sin YOU Did Not Desire, Nor Had Any Pleasure In, which are offered by the Law;

“Then Said HE, “**Low, I Come To Do THY Will O GOD. HE Takes Away The First (Old Testament) That HE Might Establish The Second (New Testament). By which Will we are Sanctified Through The Offering OF THE BODY OF JESUS CHRIST ONCE FOR ALL. —Heb 10:5-14.**

“And every (other) priest stands daily ministering and offering often times the same sacrifices which can never take away sins:

BUT THIS MAN (JESUS), After HE Had Offered ONE SACRIFICE For Sins For Ever, SAT DOWN AT THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD: From There Expecting Till HIS Enemies Be Made HIS Footstool.

“FOR BY ONE OFFERING HE HAS PERFECTED FOREVER THEM THAT ARE SANCTIFIED.

JESUS OFFERED HIMSELF, And that one offering was enough to make us PERFECTED, teleioo, means To Complete, Accomplish, Consummate, Finish, Perfected. JESUS Said “IT IS FINISHED!” on the Cross as HE Was Dying.

SANCTIFIED, hagiazo, To Make Holy, Purify.

JESUS SACRIFICE PURIFIES US!

“The HOLY SPIRIT Is Also A Witness, For HE Said “This Is The Covenant (Testament) That I Will Make with them after those days, saith The Lord, I Will Put MY Laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I Write them. And their Sins and Iniquities will I remember no more. Now where Remission of Sin Is, there is no more Offering for Sin. Heb 9:15-18. INIQUITIES, anomia, means Violation Of Law, Illegality. REMISSION, aphesis, means Freedom, Pardon, Deliverance.

EVERY HUMAN SINCE ADAM.

“For All Have Sinned And Fall Short Of The Glory Of GOD.” — Romans 3:23.

So Under the Old Covenant, Only the high priest could appear before God’s Presence once a year.

“And having an High Priest Over The House Of GOD (Church); Let us draw near with A True Heart In Full Assurance Of Faith. Having our heart sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Now GOD And Sinner Are Brought Together By The Cross.
